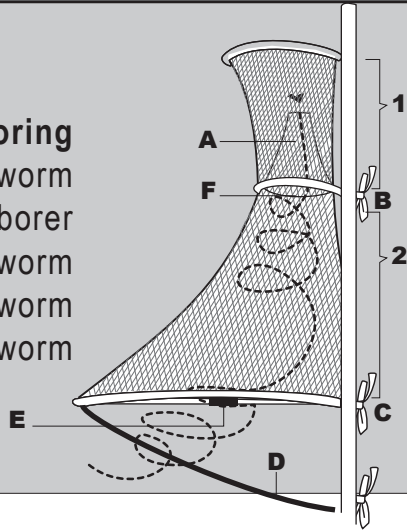


HELIOTHIS TRAP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

For Use in Monitoring

- Tobacco budworm
- European corn borer
- Tomato fruitworm
 - Corn earworm
- Cotton bollworm



Assembly

The trap comes in two parts. Reshape the mesh upon removal from the package so that the inner cone (A) at the top is extended and open. Assemble by fitting the smaller top cone (1) over the bottom cone (2) and secure with the velcro strap (F).

Mounting

Trap should be mounted on a pole or stake long enough to be driven firmly into the ground and position the trap above the crop. The bottom of the trap should be about two inches (5 cm) above the tops of the plants.

Tie the trap tightly to the pole with attached tapes (B) and (C) to prevent it from sliding down, and secure the long front tape (D) either to the pole or to a stake (enclosed) to prevent it from flapping in the wind.

Lure Placement

Attach the pheromone lure to the elastic band in the center of the large opening at the base of the trap using a paper clip or a foldback binder clip (E).

To avoid cross contamination, each trap should be used to monitor only one species.
